## **How To Get Help with the Writing Process on campus with Ellipsis**

This short workshop will touch on some of the differences between English and German academic writing, as well as present some of the ways that Ellipsis, a free service offered by the Bielefeld University *Fachsprachenzentrum*, can help with academic writing in English.

## **How to write theses and papers in TEFL**

We will answer all questions you may have regarding writing your BA/M.Ed. thesis in TEFL. Please go through the material provided in the LernraumPlus before the meeting and bring questions that are relevant to you. Besides general aspects, we can also discuss individual ideas for BA/M.Ed. theses.

## **How to Praxissemester (Sec. Schools / Primary Schools)**

This Q&A workshop deals with the Praxissemester (for M.Ed. students). We will try to answer all questions you may have concerning the English part of the Praxissemester (including VPS, BPS, RPS and the VRPS module as such). It is essential that you watch the input video provided in the LernraumPlus before the workshop and bring questions that the video raises / does not answer.

## **How to BA**

Come join Brian to look at the individual programs of the BA in British and American Studies. Here you will have the opportunity to get information and ask questions about which courses, modules and exams you need to finish your bachelor program. Students in semester 2+ are also welcome!

## **How to write theses and papers in linguistics - and what to write about**

We'll consider how to approach term papers and theses in linguistics, and what sorts of topics to choose.

## **How to PM4**

Students who have already taken the exam will give advice on how to revise and prepare, and the PM4 tutors will introduce themselves.

## **How to do Internationalisation@Home and Praxisstudien**

This session focuses on the Praxisstudien (fw) and on the Internationalization at Home option for students doing teaching degrees who are unable to go abroad during their BA. We'll answer your questions and suggest ways you can complete these modules.
